Commissioned by the Foundation De Heksenwaag of Oudewater, a sketch plan was produced for the refurbishment of 'de Waag van Oudewater' (the scales of Oudewater) as a story museum. The design is based upon the museum concepts of Machteld Löwensteyn. The main principles for the refurbishment of the ground floor are the layout, functional organisation and surveillance. The refurbishment of the upper floor required greater flexibility to accommodate the various uses, the adventure of discovering and the inventing of stories.
